The parallel use of the Good Lives Model (GLM), praise, positive role modelling, behaviour management techniques and intervention strategies, provides and promotes consistency in staff approaches and expectations, whilst enabling pupils to work towards specific educational targets and objectives to gain a sense of integrated achievement.

The Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator, who is employed by Amberleigh Care, will regularly monitor statements.

A Head of Education who is responsible for the strategic management and leadership of the schools at Telford and Welshpool leads education provided by Amberleigh Care. An Education Manager supports the Head of Education and supports with the responsibility for the day-to-day operational management and leadership of the school.

Teaching staff are all qualified to varying degrees all of whom have a proactive, enthusiastic, and creative approach to teaching and learning within this specialist environment. The Education Manager takes full responsibility for the 'designated teacher role' and attends relevant meetings arranged for Looked After Children.

Governing Body

The Local Governing Body comprises 9 people, including the Head of Education, who have voluntarily taken on the role of Governor. Each Governor carries out his or her responsibilities through a variety of contacts with the School, including individual visits and attendance at formal meetings.

We are fortunate Amberleigh, that we have been able to attract people with a variety of talent and experience who are willing to give their time and commitment in support of the school.

The core functions of the Governing Body can be described as:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos, and strategic direction
- Holding the Head of Education to account for the educational performance of the school and its students
